

Trial Lens Policy

Trial lenses are intended to compliment the fitting service and not to be used as replacement lenses.

With examination procedures: up to 6 pair of trial lenses until final initial fit is established; one pair at no charge with each annual contact lens maintenance exam.

Subsequent lenses will follow the following schedule:

Current (non-expired) Rx: one pair of complimentary lenses may be given per year (if we have them in stock) while boxes of lenses are being ordered. No trials may be given unless boxes have been ordered by our office.

CL prescription is expired within the past 12 months: 1 trial pair may be given if patient schedules examination within 2 weeks. No more trials will be dispensed without a contact lens examination.

CL prescription is expired more than 12 months: No lenses may be dispensed without a contact lens examination.

Please remember this service is provided as a CONVENIENCE for emergency replacement. The most efficient and economical way to purchase disposable contact lenses is to purchase a year's supply at the time of the exam.

Expiration Date

We adhere to guidelines set forth by the National Fairness to Contact Lens Consumers Act of 2004 which states that contact lens prescriptions are valid for one year from the date of your exam. An annual comprehensive examination and contact lens evaluation is required to renew the prescription.

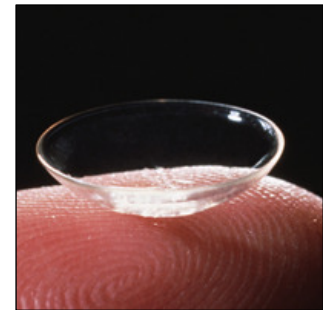

The Contact Lens Fitting

Contact lenses are medical devices that require thorough testing to ensure accuracy and safety. After your Comprehensive Eye Exam, your doctor can discuss contact lens options and schedule you for a contact lens evaluation. This includes evaluation of the lenses on your eyes to ensure good ocular health and fitting as well as optimal vision. Included in new fittings are up to 6 pairs of trial lenses and up to 60 days of follow-up visits to maintain continued success. Visits in excess of 60 days will be charged per visit.

Standard fees apply for soft disposable lenses that correct basic nearsightedness or farsightedness.

Specialty fitting fees apply for patients that require more difficult prescriptions, such as astigmatism and those desiring both distance and near correction.

Upon completion of the evaluations, the doctor will determine your wearing and replacement schedule and, if approved, you may purchase a one-year supply of lenses. **A comprehensive eye exam and contact lens evaluation is required each year to keep your contact lens prescription current.**

Contact Lens Fittings and Evaluations may or may not be covered by your insurance. If you do not have coverage, you are responsible for any charges incurred.

Purchasing Your Contact Lenses

The best way to purchase your contact lenses is by ordering an annual supply. This is the most cost-effective way to purchase because there are product rebates and discounts to offset your expense. Also, for your convenience, we offer free shipping on all annual supply orders.

Purchasing an annual supply decreases the chance of running out of lenses before your next appointment and eliminates the worry of finding time in your busy schedule to remember to order lenses.

You also don't need to worry about prescription changes throughout the year and having unused lenses with the annual supply. Should your prescription change within the year, we will exchange any lenses purchased from our office for those of the new prescription.

You may also purchase your contact lenses on a per box basis if you so desire.

We offer three convenient ways to order your contact lenses. You may purchase your lenses by stopping by or calling one of our office locations during normal business hours, or order online at www.digbyeye.com, 24 hours a day.

Contact Lens Fees

Standard Fit – New wearer (has never worn contacts - includes \$25 instruction fee and 60 day follow up) \$90

Standard Fit – Experienced wearer, new to Digby Eye (includes 60 day follow-up) \$65

Refit Eval – Established patient who requires follow-up due to significant change in prescription or a different lens type (includes 60 day follow-up) \$45

Maintenance Evaluation Established contact lens patient who has maintained yearly examinations (includes minor prescription updates with same lens type, no follow-up included) \$25

Contact Lens follow up visits in excess of 60 days from exam date but less than one year \$25

Specialty Fitting – added to above charges

Toric Fitting – (astigmatism) \$ 35

Bifocals, Multifocals, or Monovision \$ 60
